

As you may know, this newsletter is put together months before the distribution so the information given here may be out-of-date as the projects are dynamic in nature. Be sure to check the website www.warwick-bucks.org for the most up to date information.

WHERE TO BEGIN? As we approach year two of the Route 263 PennDOT reconstruction project, it is likely that you have been caught in parking lot conditions as you try to make your way through the Township. Despite warning about the upcoming inconveniences, we find that living it is another thing altogether.

I write this article in the midst of utility relocations and traffic lane relocations. What next? If all goes according to the latest PennDOT plans, Almshouse Road will be closed at York Road intersection for the summer beginning June 20, 2015. The East side (towards Northampton) will close first, followed by the West side (toward Doylestown). The Township, with the assistance of Representative O'Neill, met with members of the Board of Supervisors, key PennDOT personnel, Stacey Mulholland from Congressman Fitzpatrick's office, and the principal and key personnel from J.D. Eckman, the contractor on this project. The focus of this meeting was to discuss possible ways to shorten the duration of this project. This portion of the project will move to seven days a week in an attempt to do so.

York Road will be open throughout the Almshouse Road closures and access to businesses will be maintained. The proposed detour is shown, left, but many will likely go through your neighborhoods to get where they are going. Please understand that roads are for public transport and unless there is a truck or weight restriction, vehicles can legally travel on them, despite the inconvenience.

Our Emergency Management Coordinator, Chief Mark Goldberg, hosted a meeting with the local emergency responders to review alternate routes and response plans during this closure. Fire companies and ambulance companies are working together to assure service throughout the closure and have made adjustments for the existing work as well.

In 2016, the project anticipates closing Bristol Road at York Road for that summer. We are also addressing this issue in the same way.

Finally, (well we hope this is the last bit of road closure news), PennDOT, through a culvert replacement project will be closing Almshouse Road for several months to replace the culvert between Land Road and Guinea Lane. The original date was fall 2015, but we have requested a delay due to the Route 263 project. More information on all of these projects will be posted at www.warwick-bucks.org.


Planning any renovations or additions to your property? If so, remember that it is a requirement of the Township for property owners to secure permits. Permits are required for all new work, additions, and alterations that involve structural changes. Permits are not required for simple changes to interior and exterior finishes. Visit the "Permits & Forms" section of the Township website (www.warwick-bucks.org) for a detailed list of permits and supplemental information.



Planning on selling your property? Please note that if there was any work done to the property without securing a permit, fees will be doubled and a certificate of occupancy will not be issued. A certificate of occupancy is required prior to settlement. Prior to the issuance of certificate of occupancy a final inspection will need to be completed. It is the ultimate responsibility of the owner selling the property to obtain the appropriate permit(s) needed.

MOLAND PARK - The Newest Addition to Our Park System

Planning and patience has finally paid off in the form of our new Moland Park lands. The 50 acre parcel, located adjacent to the new Warwick Meadows homes, will be accessed from York Road, South of Meyer Way. The newly constructed road will be Moland Drive and may be here as soon as 2015. The Fifty (50) acre park features a lot of wooded area, native wildlife and plants and accessible from the Historical Moland House by foot. The Board of Supervisors accepted dedication of the parcel in 2014 which will include a stone parking area and some trails (see photograph).

Creating a walkable community is a goal of the Township. The Board is exploring a pedestrian connection between the existing historical Moland House to the new parcel. The trail would take you under Route 263 and connect the two parcels, giving visitors both the experience of the serene trails of the Moland Park and an opportunity to explore the historical Moland House.

Did you know that you can picnic at the Moland House? Did you know there is a natural areas trail there? The Township will likely expand the concept of the natural areas trail after the connection is made.

After the hassle of the state road project, we can all look forward to a nice walk through the new parklands with a picnic and a historical tour included. It's sure to be a Township treasure!

The Warwick Police Department consists of 16 officers, dedicated to protect and serve the Warwick Township community. Thirteen of our officers are assigned to Patrol, two are assigned to Detectives, led by Chief of Police Mark Goldberg. It is hoped that by the time this article is published, a 17th officer will have been hired and assigned to Patrol.

IN AN EMERGENCY, COMMUNICATION WITH THE POLICE DEPARTMENT SHOULD BE VIA TELEPHONE USING 9-1-1.

Non-emergency calls that require a police response should be directed to 215-343-0100. The office can be reached at 215-343-6102, Monday-Friday 8am - 4pm. You can e-mail the office at warwickpolice@comcast.net, and our fax number is 215-343-8165.

The Police Department is active on Twitter. Follow @warwickpdbusks for timely police information. **Do not tweet emergency information to the Police Department! The account is not monitored 24/7.** Other police information is available on the Township web site www.warwick-bucks.org. For information on how to prepare for an emergency or disaster, go to www.readypa.org. Do this before the emergency!

Bucks County and Warwick Township use the Roam Secure Alert Network to immediately contact you during a major crisis or emergency. The Roam Secure Alert Network delivers important emergency alerts, notifications, and updates to you on all your devices:

- email accounts (work, home, other)
- smartphone/PDA (iPhone, Android, Blackberry, Treo & other handhelds)
- cell phone (via SMS)
- pager

When a critical incident or emergency occurs, authorized senders will instantly notify you using the Roam Secure Alert Network. The Roam Secure Alert Network is your personal connection to real-time updates, instructions on where to go, what to do, or what not to do, who to contact and other important information. You must register for this at <https://bucks.alertpa.org/index.php?CCheck=1>. **This is the primary means for emergency communication in Warwick Township during a critical incident!**

Medication Drop Box

The Warwick Township Police Department has a permanent medication drop box available in the police department lobby. Residents may use the box to dispose of their old medications – no questions will be asked. The following rules apply to disposal:

- Controlled and non-controlled medications along with over-the-counter medications will be accepted.
- Liquids and creams in containers as well as inhalers will be accepted.
- Participants will dump their medications into the box including the pill bottles or blister packs. They will not be emptied from their containers
- This is completely anonymous; no personal information will be requested or taken.
- **Illegal substances will not be accepted. Syringes will not be accepted.**

Recognizing a need to keep medications from falling into the wrong hands, Warwick Township, The Bucks County District Attorney's Office, and the Bucks County Drug and Alcohol Commission have provided the funding for the drop box. The police department lobby is open every business day from 8am to 4pm. For questions, or to

schedule an after-hours disposal of medication, please contact Corporal Aaron Richwine, 215-343-6102, ext. 411.

Our officers regularly participate in scheduled "TAKE BACK DAYS," with the District Attorney's Office and the Bucks County Drug and Alcohol Commission. The police station is opened, usually on a Saturday, and officers accept prescription medications for drop off. These "Take Back Days" are held across the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Bucks County typically leads the state in the quantity of medications turned in for disposal.

Below are the numbers for the 5 county area, for two recent Take Back Days:

HOME FIRE SAFETY TIPS:

- Conduct a home fire drill and designate a safe family meeting place.
- BE CAREFUL COOKING.** Keep cooking areas clear of combustibles and wear short or tight-fitting sleeves when you cook. Keep the handles of your pots turned inward so they do not over-hang the stove. If grease catches fire, carefully slide a lid over the pan and smother the flames, then turn off the burner.
- Charcoal and propane grills should only be used outdoors. The grill should be placed well away from home, deck railings and out from under eaves. WIRELESS INTERCONNECTED SMOKE DETECTORS

Ed Pfeiffer, Fire Marshal ~ New Technology for Older Homes

WHY?

Residential Fire Safety has been reduced to these two questions. If you can answer them positively, you have a fire safe home. If you can't, your family is at some risk for an undetected fire.

CAN YOU HEAR ALL OF YOUR SMOKE DETECTORS FROM ANYWHERE IN YOUR HOME, ESPECIALLY FROM YOUR BEDROOM WHEN YOU ARE ASLEEP?

DO YOU HAVE ENOUGH DETECTORS TO SENSE THE EARLIEST PRESENCE OF SMOKE EVERYWHERE IN YOUR HOME?

Everyone who has been injured, burned or died in a residential fire was home at the time the fire began. Had they known of the early presence of smoke, they could have escaped. They may have had time to take action to prevent the smoke from developing into a fire.

WHERE?

Today's International Building Code requires a detector in each bedroom, outside the bedrooms and on each level. Open areas may only require one detector. Example: The first floor of a typical home includes a kitchen, dining room and living room all with a common ceiling with no doors between rooms. If a detector is

present on the second floor at the top of the stairs, it will cover the three first floor rooms. A detector at the top of the basement stairs (assuming there are no separate basement rooms) will cover the entire basement. A detector in each bedroom and the garage will require seven interconnected detectors in an average three bedroom home.

HOW?

- Purchase "Wireless Interconnected Smoke Detectors"
- Remove all of the detectors from their boxes and separate all of the individual components (all batteries together, all anchors and screws together, etc.).
- Set the 8 position "DIP" switch to any combination (of up or down), as long as that combination is the same for all of your detectors.
- Install the batteries in all detectors. Note proper positions.
- Place all of the detectors on a table and push and hold the test button until all of the red lights are flashing.
- Mount the detectors on the ceiling at least 12 inches from any wall. Place the basement detector at the top of the stairs.
- The garage detector should be mounted several feet from the wall near the door to the home.
