Park Directors Update

- Update on Park Board – Unfortunately, Greg Firely had to resign from the Board due to a personal conflict. No direction has been given yet as to a replacement at this point.
- PA Child Protective Services Law update – DS informed the Board that the majority of the Board is 2/3 of the way towards completing the necessary clearances and some have them completed in full. DS also informed the Board about the new updated bill HB 1276 that made changes to some of the fees associated with the clearances as well as the time frame for renewal.
- Moland Park Update – DS showed the Board the final approved plan that the Board of Supervisors adopted at their May meeting.
- 2015 Capital Budget update – DS informed the Board that the majority of the capital projects for 2015 have been completed. The one large project that is outstanding is the resurfacing of the tennis courts at Guinea Lane Park. DS recommended to the Board that we remove the tennis courts completely and replace it with four more pickleball courts. There was discussion by the Board and they felt they like the flexibility of both tennis and pickleball courts and they would like them to remain as they are and to just make the necessary repairs as originally planned.

Motion – Mark Goldberg made a motion in accordance with the 2015 Capital Budget to make the repairs to the tennis courts at Guinea Lane Park keeping the flexibility of both tennis and pickleball. The Board also requested that a wooden rebound wall be installed on one of the tennis courts. Seconded by Christina Jones-Davidson. ALL in favor.

- 2016 Capital Budget proposed – DS informed the Board that there are five items proposed in the budget for 2016. 1. Repair and resurface the basketball courts in the Community Park; 2. Resurface the spray pole area and repair the drain (this may be removed after thoroughly cleaning the existing surface); 3. Replace the spray pole; 4. Install drainage near the playground in the Community Park; 5. Playground mulch for playground areas
