

ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Sealed electronic bids will be received by Warwick Township, hereinafter generally referred to as the Township, on February 14, 2019 until 10:00 (Prevailing Time) via the PennBID Electronic Bid Management System and opened shortly thereafter. All documents and solicitation details will be available on or after January 19, 2019 at www.ebidexchange.com/pennbid. Bidders must register (a free process), then click on the "Solicitations", then "View" tabs.

2019 ROADWAY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM CONTRACT NO. 5100-183 WARWICK TOWNSHIP BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

The Base Contract will generally include the overlay of thirteen Township roadways (37,980 SY/3,535 Ton). The Base Contract will also include 1,050 L.F. of concrete curb replacements, 3,770 S.F. of concrete sidewalk replacements, 112 L.F. of concrete cheek wall, 26 truncated dome inserts, 3,705 S.Y. pavement repair, 19,160 L.F. curblin/intersection driveway milling, 175 Gal. rubberized crack seal, 505 Tons leveling/scratch course, 90 L.F. Type 2 Strong Post Guiderail, Two Permanent Impact Attenuating Devices and the replacement of all pavement markings as detailed in Section VII of the Specifications.

The Base Contract will also include the overlay of a portion of the parking area at the Municipal Complex (5,700 S.Y./520 Ton). The work will also include 25 L.F. concrete curb replacements, 120 S.F. concrete sidewalk replacements, 2 truncated dome inserts, 300 S.Y. pavement repair, 970 L.F. curblin/intersection/driveway milling, 100 Gal. rubberized crack seal and 70 Tons of leveling/scratch course.

Alternate/Add-On No. 1 will include the mill (1-1/2 inch depth) and overlay (1,000 S.Y./90 Ton) of the Township hockey rink located adjacent to the Municipal Complex.

Alternate/Add-On No. 2 will generally include the placement of pavement markings in the overlay area at the Municipal Complex and detailed in Section VII of the Specifications.

Proposals must be made upon the forms furnished by the Township, as available on PennBid.

Proposals must be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond in the amount of 10% of the total bid amount for the work detailed in Attachment #1, including all Alternate/Add-On items.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish separate bonds with corporate surety issued by companies authorized to do business in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania on the prescribed forms dated the date of the Contract, or separate Federal or Commonwealth chartered lending institution irrevocable letters of credit in a form accepted and approved by the Township, each equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract amount, to secure (a) the faithful performance and maintenance of the Contract; and (b) the prompt payment of materials and labor.
